WATER SOURCES FOR GENESEE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUILDINGS AND PROGRAM LOCATIONS

The following Genesee Intermediate School District (GISD) buildings and program locations (regardless of the city or township to which they belong) receive water from Genesee County Water and Waste, which uses water purchased from Detroit:

- Business Services
- Early Childhood Programs and Services (located in the SESC-South building)
- Early Learning Center (located on the property of Holy Redeemer)
- Elmer A. Knopf Learning Center
- Erwin L. Davis Education Center
- Genesee Career Institute
- Health, Safety, and Nutrition Services (former SESC-North building)
- Marion D. Crouse Instructional Center
- The Learning Community (located in Carman-Ainsworth Fenton Lawn building)
- Transition Center

GISD's Ligon Outdoor Center (located in Thetford Township) has wells for each building on the property.

The GISD Head Start program located at Beecher Dailey Elementary receives its water from the Beecher Metropolitan District. The water comes from three (3) public wells.

GISD program locations receiving FLINT CITY WATER include:

- Genesee Early College (located on the campus of UM-Flint)
- Mott Middle College (located on the campus of Mott Community College)
- GISD Head Start programs located at the Summerfield and Manley buildings in the Flint Community Schools
- Various additional GISD Head Start programs located around the City of Flint
