### Expectations

The (3) nonprofit tables we use for our youth entrepreneurs is a service provided by the market as a courtesy so we have to follow the rules they have in place when we are guests. *This market does NOT allow non-profits to sell food.*

The atrium where the tables are is designed as a meeting and eating place first and foremost.

\*Students must stay within the table space.

\*Students are not allowed to have family & friends near the tables while selling nor sitting in the atrium if they are not eating. (vendors & customers will complain and our students not be allowed to sell at the market in the future)

\*6 students in the morning and 6 students in the afternoon

-Morning 9am-12pm lunch @12:15pm (3 students)

-Afternoon 1pm-4pm lunch @12:30pm (3 students)

-All Day 9am-4pm (3 students)

\*Lunch will be paid for by GISD YE Program\*

\*Morning students need to have their product cleared out by 12:15 pm, no exceptions.

\*Afternoon students need to be setup and ready to go by 12:45pm and products cleared out by 3:45pm.

\*Advisors are allowed to come and take pictures but are not allowed behind the tables or sit in the atrium unless they are eating. You may help students set up and get prepared, but please let them do all of the talking, selling, communicating with their customers to obtain the full experience.

**If any of these rules are not followed students would be asked to leave.**

## More Information for Students:

When you arrive, you will receive \$10 coupon to go and buy your lunch and then you can set up your table. Please plan to set up a display that will “WOW” the customers. It should include props, posters with PRICING INFORMATION, handouts (like flyers or business cards), social media scan codes, freebies/samples if you want and maybe a tablecloth. BRING AS MUCH OF YOUR PRODUCT AS YOU CAN--and I recommend putting them in boxes or tubs. Bring bags to put your products in for those that purchase many items.
